BE IT RESOLVED, that the National Catholic Committee on Scouting and Learning for Life will work cooperatively with each other, within the policies, procedures, safety guidelines and regulations of each organization, to establish and nurture Learning for Life groups and Explorer Posts/Clubs so that men and women may grow in character, citizenship responsibility, and career development necessary to achieve their full potential in life.
